

cardinal points of the compass, which they call Geering (north), Booyong (south), Kokkar (east), and Wunnekal (west). He adds that he has often tried to puzzle them as to bearings, compass in hand, but could never succeed. This knowledge, he remarks, was indigenous to all the tribes in those parts, and not acquired from the Whites. Of a compass or its object they had not the least idea in their wild state.

In the vocabulary the verb *drink* is rendered *water eat*.
