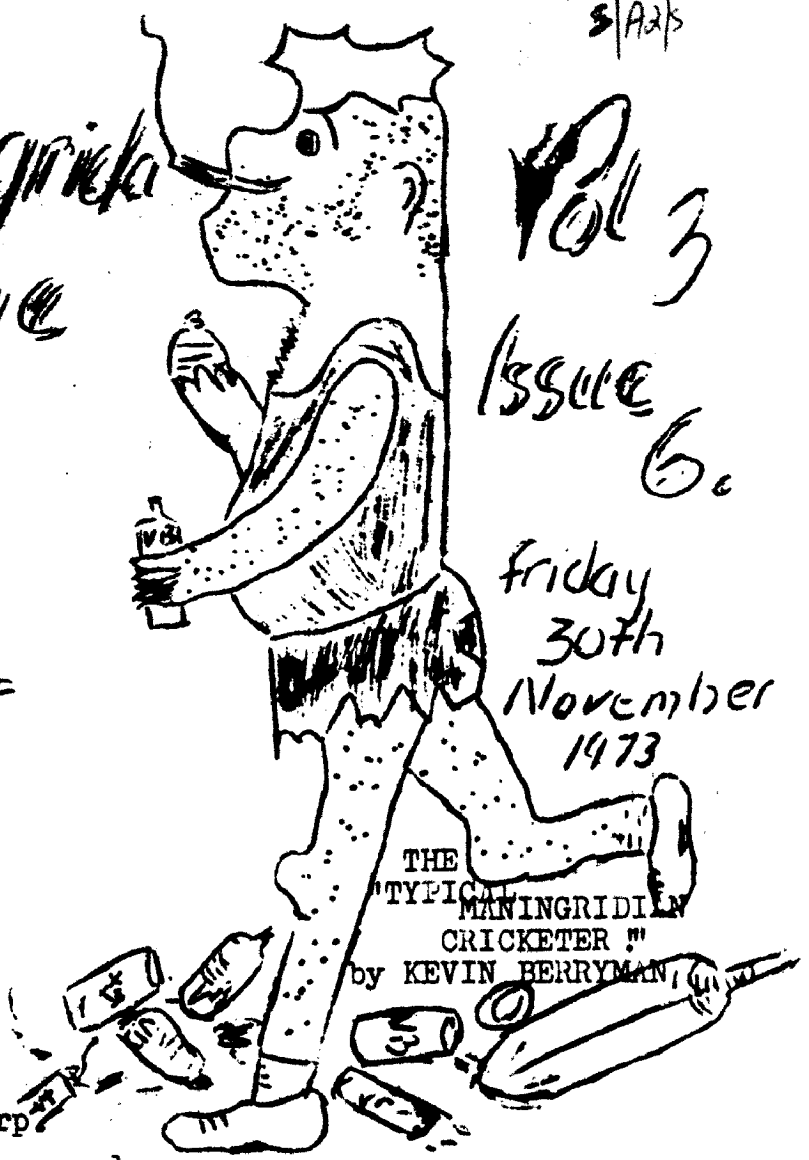

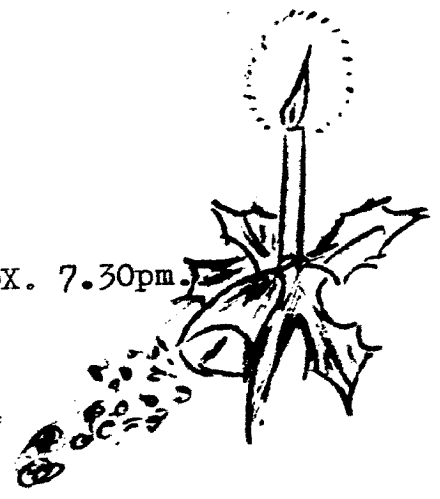
By Public Demand, a repeat performance of the Super Super -

IMAGINATION POEMS FROM GRADES 5 & 6THE WATER - by Doreen Jingarrarrbarra grade 5



I am water


THE FLOWER by Patrick Mudjara grade 6

Tuesday 1 January 1974	New Years Day

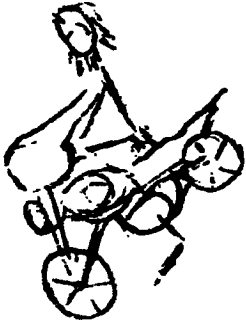
